Discounted Admission to Four Attractions on October 31st

MACON, GA – The Georgia Sports Hall of Fame, Georgia Music Hall of Fame, Georgia Children’s Museum, and Tubman African American Museum will transform into Halls of Fright that will have children scared silly this Halloween. On Saturday, October 31st, a single ticket will allow admission to all four of the museums.

At each of the museums, children will be able to participate in Halloween games or crafts activities and will, of course, be able to get some candy. “This is a fun and unique way to introduce children to the many cultural institutions in our community,” said Jackie Decell, GSHF Executive Director. “We’re all looking forward to sharing our facilities in this relaxed, informal, and safe atmosphere.”

Tickets are available now at each of the museums. Advance tickets are \$10 for children 5-16 and \$18 for adults. Tickets purchased on the 31st are \$12 for children in costume and \$21 for adults. Without a costume, children’s admission is \$13, and adult admission is \$24.

Tickets will be honored beginning at 9:00 a.m., but the activities will begin at noon and run through 5:00 p.m. Volunteers are needed and can register to help in the Locker Room Gift Store at the Georgia Sports Hall of Fame.
